We spent two days at Rednock, handing out pens and leaflets to the children.

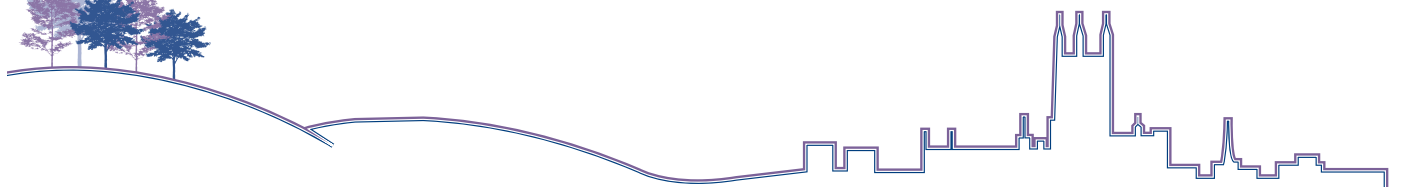
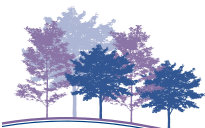


### Football
